

## Suggested Activities for Summer Reading

Use a double bubble map to compare two characters, events, or settings from the text	Find the definitions for 10 vocabulary words from the book and write a sentence for each one	Write a summary of a chapter or event from the book	Use a flow map to explain several events in order from the story
Draw a diagram of something that was described	Create a comic strip for several events from the story	Write a letter to the author that explains your opinion of the story	Create interview questions for a character in the story and create answers based on what you think the character would say
Create a movie/TV show trailer for the book	Create a new cover for the book from a cereal box that includes art and a brief summary	Create an illustrated timeline of the major events in the book	Create an Instagram or Facebook profile for one of the characters in the book
Create a video of a scene from the book	Construct a 3D model of some aspect of the book and label the components	Create a board game to go along with the book that includes elements of the story	Create a song or poem about the characters, events, or setting of the story
Create an advertisement (poster, commercial) that would encourage someone else to read the book	Create an App that relates to the story and explain how the applications relate to the book	Create a trivia game that is based on the book	Add an additional chapter at the beginning or end of the story to further explain events
Pick five events and write cause and effect statements for those event or create a multi-flow map of an event	Create 5 predictions about what you think will happen later in the story	Pick a scene or setting from the story that is described in detail and draw a picture to illustrate it	Choose a character from the book and imagine you walked into their room. What would you find and draw what it would look like
Draw a picture of one of the characters and describe them in detail	Make connections to the story including a connection to your own life, to another book you have read, or to an event in the world	Create a test/quiz for the book. Include the questions and an answer key	Create a collage that relates to the characters, setting, or events in the story
